and he cannot be found in noise and restlessness.

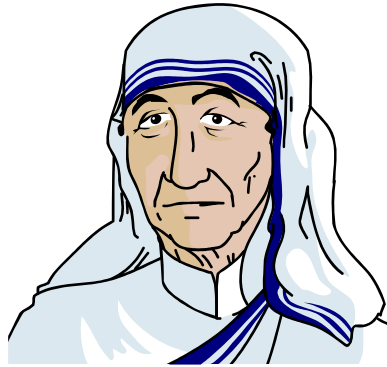
God is a friend of silence.
