Catholic Relief Services Update: Haiti Earthquake – Six Months Later

In the six months following the earthquake in Haiti, CRS has been working to assist 900,000 made vulnerable by the devastation. Relief has come in the form of programs in food relief, emergency shelters, water provisions and sanitation, health consultations and emergency operations, seed fairs for agriculture stimulation, protection through safe zones for the vulnerable and cash-for-work opportunities.
