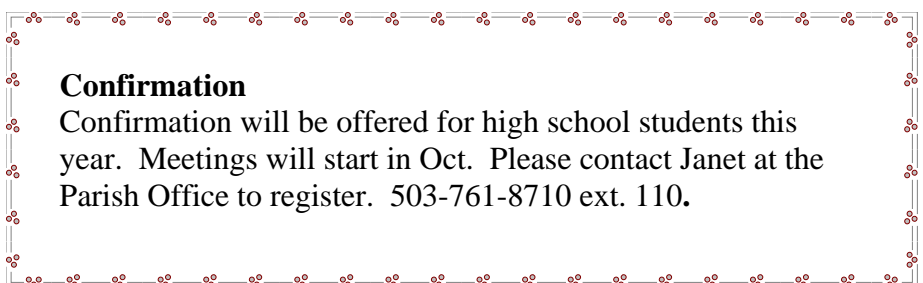
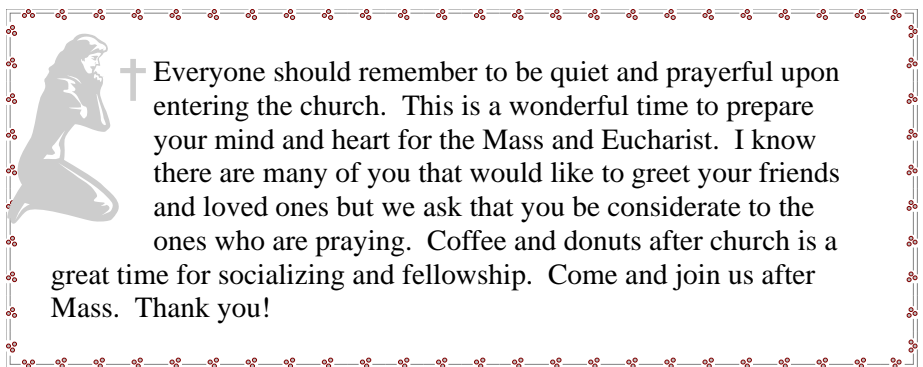
Take time to reflect on how different people have affirmed the good fruits of Jesus in your life.

Homeless Outreach:

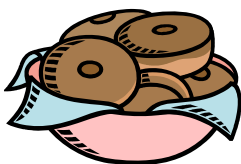
