The Armstrong Scholarship for St. Joseph the Worker Parish is given to high school students who have demonstrated their involvement at the parish through liturgical and youth group activities and who have plans for continuing education in the fall each year. A fundraising dinner for the scholarship is planned in the near future. Established in 2013 by the Mastroieni family, the scholarship has awarded over \$25,000 in scholarships to graduating high school parishioners over the past seven years.
